

# Download Forest Conditions Of Nova Scotia

The mission of the Forest Protection Division is to maintain the health of Nova Scotia's woodlands by protecting them from pests and fires. Staff and resources are allocated into three sections to efficiently apply science to the maintenance of forest health in Nova Scotia. Nova Scotia's forests are a mainstay of life. While the requirement to provide wood fibre to support our forest economy is still a primary concern, there is a need to sustain the quality and character of our forest resource and maintain a varied forest ecosystem.
