

Download Railway Company V. Ramsey

Ramsey is the northern terminus of the Manx Electric Railway and is the start of the mountain section of the Snafell Mountain Course used for the annual Isle of Man TT and Manx Grand Prix motorcycle races. The Great Northern Railway (GNR) was a British railway company established by the Great Northern Railway Act of 1846. On 1 January 1923 the company lost its identity, as a constituent of the newly formed London and North Eastern Railway.
